

# Railway law for experts according to the German § 33 EBO and experts

## DESCRIPTION

This seminar covers the basic training for expert candidates according to § 33 EBO or experts and is suitable as preparation for the recognition as an expert for installations requiring monitoring at the Federal Railway Authority. In addition, this seminar is aimed at all interested parties from the railway industry who would like to deepen or update their knowledge of the current legal provisions and the interaction of the various players.

The three-day seminar is divided into a general part, which extends over two days. The third seminar day is relevant for experts and appraisers (candidates).

The third day mainly includes preparation for the written and oral examination at the Federal Railway Authority, which has to be taken if you want to be recognised as an expert.

After successfully passing the exam, you will receive a certificate of attendance.
